- I. Meeting called to order by Corie at 6:31 pm
- II. Old Business
 - a. Meeting minutes are up-to-date
- III. Secretary: Kim Bonifera
 - a. No report
- IV. Director: Don Magee
 - a. Staff and faculty will receive a form on 7/15/20 so they can identify their preference (virtual or in-person). Due date for form was not communicated
 - b. School board will vote on 7/15/20 regarding 50% proposal
 - c. Mr. Magee would like to send something out to families by the end of the week based on the information received in the next two days
 - d. We will have marching band—it is a class. Mr. Magee will do as much as he can
 - i. Even though it's a class, the level of participation will probably follow the guidelines that activities must follow
 - ii. We will not have band camp the week of 8/3/20
 - iii. We will not have any in-person marching until at least 8/24/20
 - iv. Nothing live until after 9/8/20
 - e. Goals will be established for when we can give performances and what they might look like
 - f. Viable performances in small groups may be an option
 - g. It is unclear if you select all virtual instruction if you can participate in in-person activities
 - h. Band may take over the auditorium for class instruction (currently not approved)
 - i. Students will be given ownership of a specific 4 x 4 space

 - a. The bank is still closed so Maria was unable to fully transition from Melanie
 - b. Not able to report bank balances
 - c. Does have access to Pay Pal
 - d. Accounts have not been charged for uniform items
 - e. Maria has credited those accounts that were charged twice due to the new Charms

 - a. Membership Stats
 - i. Original estimate was 196 students including rising ninth graders
 - ii. 6 students have indicated that they will not be returning or participating

- iii. Out of the remaining 190 students we have received registrations from 144

 - iv. There are at least 20 students who only filled out one or two of the three Google forms
