- III. Secretary: Kim Boniferaa. Kim plans to fill the Secretary position for the 2021-2022 school year
- IV. Director: Don Magee
 - a. Concert Band, Symphonic Band, and Wind Symphony
 - i. It is a joy to have kids back in the building!
 - ii. It is a challenge to engage both the in person and virtual students at the same time
 - 1. Will start to devote time specifically for at home students
 - b. Marching Band
 - i. Students are working hard even though there is no end goal
 - ii. There will be practice until the end of the school year every Tuesday and Wednesday (weather permitting)
 - iii. To assist in recruitment Mr. Magee will start to invite rising ninth graders to practice even if it is only for one hour
 - iv. Band Camp for the 2021-2022 marching season is scheduled to begin on August 2, 2021
 - 1. Two weeks/all students
 - 2. If Christian or Mr. Siberts would like to schedule something different, Mr. Magee will need to see a proposal
 - 3. Next year's game and competition schedule is still not decided
 - a. Bus transportation for away games and competitions will be a problem because of the number of students allowed on one bus
 - b. Woodbridge High School has committed to some variation of their Viking Invitational
 - c. Colgan is committed to some variation of the Colgan Classic
 - c. End of year concerts
 - i. The Governor has classified a school performance as a social gathering with a current maximum of 100 people indoors. 500 people are allowed outdoors.
 - ii. Concert Band, Symphonic Band, and Wind Symphony will probably play two songs each

- iii. Mr. Magee asked the students if they would be able to play in a concert
 - 1. Students were told that if their answer was "no" Mr. Magee would be contacting their parents to verify
 - a. If a student is learning in person and attending Marching Band rehearsals, there is no reason they can't participate in a live concert
- iv. There will be challenges seating everyone on the stage six feet apart
- v. May 25, 2021 is the tentatively scheduled indoor concert date
- vi. May 26, 2021 is the only evening available in the stadium
 - 1. If current limits are not lifted we may have all band performances (not just Marching Band) play outside
